1. Call to order and introductions.

2. Griffith Park to Elysian Park Community Trail and Wildlife Corridor

Resolution of support for the SMMC/MRCA's appeal for an easement to permit the conversion of the "Corralitas Car Barn Property," an existing natural, open space between Griffith and Elysian Parks into a trail linking the two parks which will hereafter be called the Griffith Park to Elysian Park Community Trail and Wildlife Corridor. This initiative is a part of the "Griffith Park to El Pueblo de Los Angeles State Historic Park Trail" that has been in the formation process since the early 1980s. (30 minutes)

3. Budget impacts, including Potential parking fee at Los Angeles Zoo parking lot in Griffith Park.

This parking area has been used by park users of all types for decades and has always been free of charge. Update on the possible new fee, currently in discussion at City Hall and other revenue-producing proposals for Griffith and other parks. (20 minutes)

4. Committee and public comment on non-agenda items (10 min)

Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only at the time the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on matters not appearing on this Agenda within the Board's subject matter jurisdiction are heard during the Public Comment period, limited to 2 minutes per speaker, unless waived by the Board's presiding officer.

PROCESS FOR RECONSIDERATION: The Board may reconsider and amend its action on items listed here if that reconsideration takes place immediately following the original action, or at the next regular meeting. The Board, on either of these two days, shall: 1) Make a Motion for reconsideration and, if approved, 2) hear the matter and take an action. If the motion to reconsider an action is to be scheduled at the next meeting following the original action, then two items shall be placed on the agenda for that meeting: 1) A Motion for Reconsideration on the described matter and 2) a [Proposed] Action should the motion to reconsider be approved. A motion for reconsideration can only be made by a Board member who has previously voted on the prevailing side of the original action taken. If a motion for reconsideration is not made on the date the action was taken, then a Board member on the prevailing side of the action must submit a memorandum to the Secretary identifying the matter to be reconsidered and a brief description of the reason(s) for requesting reconsideration at the next regular meeting. The aforesaid shall all be in compliance with the Ralph M. Brown Act governing public entities.
