Marshall High School – Rex Link - discussed parking lot - he is a designer of Parking Spaces-and has worked on Zoo Magnet. He will call Mr Harrison on behalf of the Education Committee. The new Track and Field was dedicated at Homecoming. There will be continued work including plants around the field

Discussion was held on asking the Beautification Committee of GGPNC giving \$2,500. For Big Blue M

Los Feliz Elementary School - \$2,500 was given for books to Los Feliz Elementary School in 2008 and Los Feliz Elementary School is to be replace tables and chairs in the library in 2009.

LA's Best to purchase table and most chairs. Need 18 chairs - \$171./chair 6 tables - \$3,100 . Chairs approved

K. Pilkington stated that there are 2,000 to 2,500 children in the school 24/class 50% Hispanic 40% Armenian "Mini U.N."

King Junior High School – Mr Jolley (not present) requested \$2000 for plans and materials for Beautification day.

\$500. For the renovation of the Indian Statue located on campus. The plaster is falling off the surface.

Request 3 trees to replace ones which have died. \$500. Deferred to Tree People

Request skim coat for block wall of amphitheater \$500.

\$1,000. Passed for the beautification and skim coating

Franklin Elementary School – request technology – Smart Board and a White Board for interactive teaching. \$2,000. Passed

Big Blue M – Dorothy Lee – Art teacher at Marshall High School –

Dora Herrera – Representative of BID

Mary Rodriguez –Representative of council district 4

Marianne Dodge – Representative of Los Feliz Improvement Association

Tile mural – contest – AP class chose 5 designs. 5 shades of blue – grant written for \$10,000 and should have an answer by mid January. Yuriko is the tile mural artist – cost \$25,000. \$20,000 for artist, \$1,200. materials, and \$2,500 for sandblast and seal. Asking for \$2,500 from both Beautification and Education Committees. Marshall Alumni association is also involved in raising funds for mural. Mike Haynes – Marshall Alumni and X Raider football player will sign items and put them on E-bay to raise funds.

Dora Herrera discussed the Empty Bowl Project. Artists make ceramic bowls to sell for fundraisers.

Bridget LeBonge was looking for mentors, people to assist with reading. according to Mary Rodriguez

Mary Rodriguez November 5 CD4 is having a collaborative education meeting with principals and educators. Recycling at schools will be discussed. Fire safety – My Safe LA will go into 4th grade and teach traffic education, safety and promote walking.

Marshall has recycling and environmental science classes. They recycle paper, cardboard and bottles.

Dora Prihar-The Master Plan for Los Feliz Disaster. There will be certification training and some attempt to organize people. There will be representatives at each school, businesses and GGPNC. Mary and Dora will get different groups together to organize schools, residences, businesses and government.

May Rodriguez said that maybe in January 2010 there will be Vision for Los Feliz, a community summit to talk of community issues of interest to Los Feliz area.
