COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT

Regarding: Designation of Griffith Park as an Historic Cultural Monument

- Council File 08-3086

Greater Griffith Park Neighborhood Council strongly supports the designation of the entirety of Griffith Park as an Historic Cultural Monument.

No part of the existing park (or any subsequent addition), especially Toyon Canyon landfill, should be excluded from the designation, but structures built in the park after 1959 (as those on Roosevelt Golf Course, the Zoo, the Tregnan school, and the Autry museum) may be demolished or modified without Office of Historic Resources' review except with respect to the effect of the same on the park generally.
