- YOUR TRUNK IS NOT A SAFE! BEWARE OF THIEVES WHO MAY BE WATCHING YOU PUT VALUABLES IN TRUNK. TAKE VALUABLES WITH YOU.
- REMOVE TRACES OF VALUABLES FROM YOUR VEHICLE SUCH AS GPS MOUNTINGS & SUCTION-SMUDGES, WIRES & CABLES, AND CHARGERS.
